SOCIAL OUTREACH MINISTRY

Due to the increase in assistance needed within our surrounding area of St. Philip Neri Church and Anne Arundel County, the Social Outreach Ministry will be partnering with the Anne Arundel Food bank to assist with the need for hunger.

For one day a month on a monthly basis we will be opening our food pantry to offer assistance. At this time we are in the process of forming a team that could help with this program. We need people willing to make a commitment to help once a month or however many months throughout the year you are available. Leo Zerhusen has volunteered to pick up the food each month from the food bank. The paper work and screening process will be done in advance and the volunteer team will be needed to merely pack and distribute food for individual families. Volunteers will be needed on a Thursday from approximately 10:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. The hours are still flexible as this is the planning process. As we are aware of the needs of so many we feel this is a wonderful opportunity to assist those within our own community and the surrounding area.
