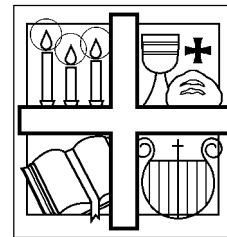

YOUTH GROUP

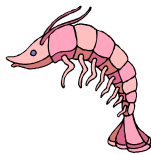
