Reason # 18

Decreased Underage Drinking

Alcohol consumption, especially heavy drinking among teenagers, has been associated with many other high risk behaviors and contributes significantly to the high death rate among teens each year. How do you prevent teens from drinking?

Parents who take their children to church may have hit on a solution. A study by R.P. Schiegel and M.D. Sanborn of 842 male and female teenagers shows an interesting relationship between religious affiliation and alcohol consumption. The study, published in the *Journal of Studies on Alcohol* showed that Protestant and Catholic teens who have a strong religious affiliation are less likely to be heavy drinkers. The study found that boys who were religious but no longer attended church had higher rates of heavy drinking.
