The National Catholic Youth Conference is an exciting, biennial three-day experience of prayer, community, and empowerment for Catholic teenagers and their adult chaperones. The schedule includes keynote addresses, concurrent and workshop sessions addressing a wide variety of topics. There are also opportunities for liturgy, reconciliation, prayer and worship, recreation and special activities such as concerts, exhibits, and the interactive thematic park. All of this alongside 20,000 other young Catholics who are excited about their faith. Ask any of the youth who attended NCYC in Kansas City in 2009- It is an experience you will not soon forget.

The cost for this trip is \$580, which will be offset by *some* fundraising.
