Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

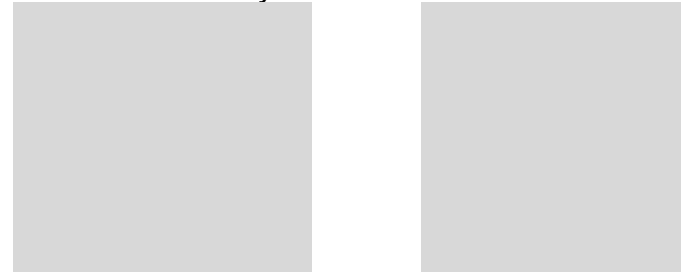

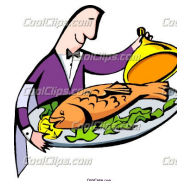


Knights of Columbus

On Sept 16, 2010 we opened our food pantry to families within our community who need additional food assistance. The pantry is opened every 3rd Thursday of each month and we have been very blessed to have the food to give these families. In listening to parishioners who would like some assistance, we have realized that the most immediate thing people would like us to do is pray for them.

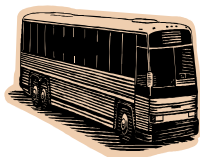

Fast and Abstinence

Good Friday and **Ash Wednesday** are the major days for fasting in general for those who have reached the age 18 and are not yet 60. Abstinence means no meat on those days for those who are age 14 [or over]. General canon law says that **all Fridays** are days of abstinence -- no meat -- but if you want to eat meat, you should substitute some other form of penance.

The US rules for abstinence from meat includes all Fridays during Lent; **Fast** (small meals, no snacks) + **Abstinence** (as in universal rules -- no meat) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
