Reason # 14

Higher Self-Esteem Among Teens

There is evidence to show that teens who have grown up attending church tend to have a better self-image than those without religious commitment.

The Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion published a study by C. B. Smith, A.J. Weigert, and D.L. Thomas in 1979 on this subject. The analysis of nearly 2,000 Catholic “middle class” adolescents from five cultures in Europe and North America showed strong evidence for a “positive relationship between adolescent self-esteem and total religiosity.” The study measured religious beliefs and practices, including church attendance.
