These are just two of the many non-profit organizations that provide non-judgmental support to girls and women who are distressed by unplanned pregnancy. These centers offer friendship, emotional support, medical and legal referrals, child care options, child safety issues and many more services. Please help us to support these programs by donating new or like new material items that will help these women and their children. You can bring your gifts to church anytime during the month of May and place them in the designated boxes in the lobbies.

Suggestions for items needed: Newborn and toddler clothing (especially toddler sizes 4,5 and 6), crib sheets, baby blankets, bottles-regular plastic not the ones that require special inserts, replacement nipples, pacifiers, pajamas, onesies, baby towels and wash cloths, lotions, shampoo, diapers (all sizes), pull-ups (boys and girls all sizes), baby wipes, pacifiers. Gently used clean clothing in any size up to 6x is also accepted. We ask that all clothing and cloth items be new or in like new condition. Your support and donations will be greatly appreciated.

On April 21st, the SPN Food Pantry served food for 47 families totaling 243 individuals. We have two wonderful teams of men and women who come together on two different time frames on the third Thursday of each month and package and help to distribute the food. These wonderful people play a very important part of the operation of the pantry and we would be lost without them. We could not do the pantry without these wonderful people! But even more, we cannot do the pantry without the food. By partnering with Anne Arundel County Food Bank, we get a great deal of donations but it is the donations of the SPN church family that we get the biggest support. Each month for the pantry we empty our shelves and it is with your support that we can re-stock them. We are in need of brown grocery bags used to pack the food. We need items that can be used as a meal such as, spaghetti and sauce, peanut butter and jelly, tuna and tuna helper, macaroni and cheese, soups, and canned ravioli.

Also needed are: cereal, oatmeal, canned fruit, vegetables, soups, canned meats, canned or boxed potatoes. The pantry is opened every 3rd Thursday of each month and we have been very blessed to have the food to give these families. As the needs continue to grow for assistance we ask for your continued support. No amount is too small! All donations can be placed in the church lobby in the box marked "Outreach".
