Influence on Future Generations

In spite of an apparent decrease in church attendance, particularly among young people, there is evidence to show a stability of church attendance in families across generations.

A study by Arland Thornton and Donald Camburn of the Institute for Social Research at the University of Michigan concluded: “These data indicate strong inter-generational transmissions if religious involvement. Attendance at religious services is also very stable within generations across time.”

This could indicate that our individual dedication to going to church regularly may have an impact on our posterity. The upshot of this, for those of us who would want the benefits of going to church for our children and grandchildren, is that we must lead by example if we expect future generations to do the same.
