Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

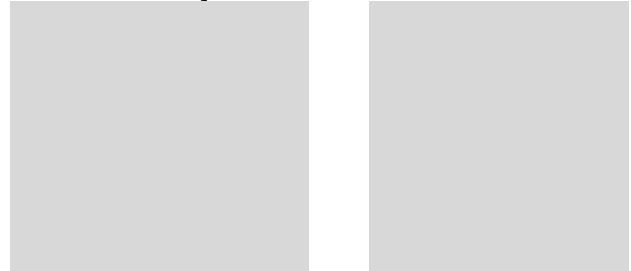

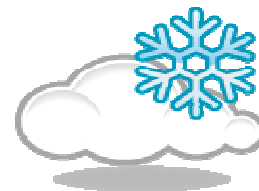
Thursday prayer meetings are held in the rectory of St. Philip Neri in Linthicum.
