Earth Week Celebrations

St. Philip Neri students from Pre-K to Grade Eight participated in many Earth Week celebrations, beginning with a prayer service and planting of a red oak tree in our field. Throughout the week students picked-up trash on the fields during their gym classes and participated in a magazine stack competition. We also worked on creating less trash at lunchtime, by bringing cloth napkins, and using recyclable utensils.

A magazine stack competition encouraged students and their families to recycle paper in our Abitibi Paper Retrievers. A 141.5 foot tall stack of magazines were collected, and Mrs. Flynn's Class 1A won the competition.

Officer Mike Lathroum with the Department of Natural Resources visited with the students to talk about endangered species and protecting wildlife. Students got an up-close look at a snake and baby alligator. Earlier in the week, baby turtles were measured and studied. It was a productive week for our students, and hopefully, for the environment!
