Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

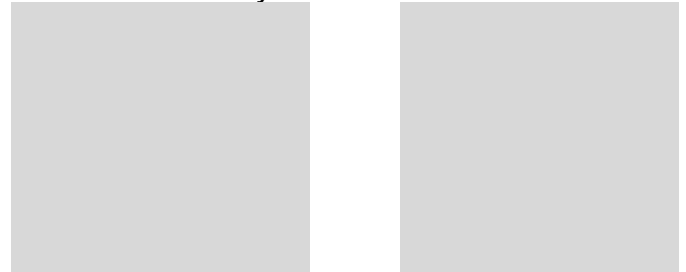
