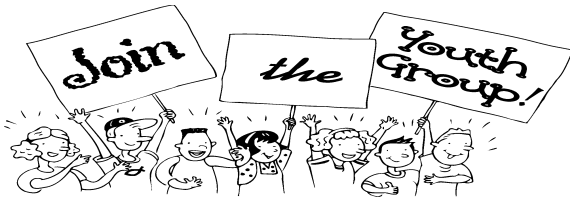
Birthright is a non-profit Organization providing caring non-judgmental support to girls and women who are distressed by unplanned pregnancy.
