**Marriage:** Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

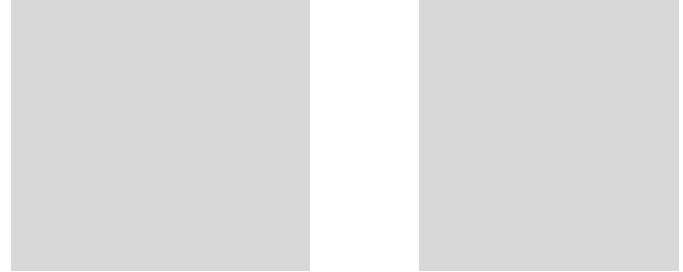

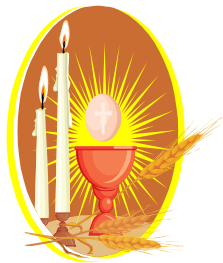
**Spring Craft Fair**

### Fast and Abstinence

**Good Friday** and **Ash Wednesday** are the major days for fasting in general for those who have reached the age 18 and are not yet 60. Abstinence means no meat on those days for those who are age 14 [or over]. General canon law says that **all Fridays** are days of abstinence -- no meat -- but if you want to eat meat, you should substitute some other form of penance.

The US rules for abstinence from meat includes all Fridays during Lent; **Fast** (small meals, no snacks) + **Abstinence** (as in universal rules -- no meat) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

How to make Jesus more relevant in my life?

*Getting to know Jesus on a personal level and making him a part of your everyday life will further develop your personal relationship with him. Daily reading of the Bible, as little as a chapter a day (about 10 minutes) will go a long way in accomplishing this. Reading the Gospels will enlighten and nourish your spiritual being as you read and learn from the words of Christ Himself, how He wants you to conduct and live your life.*

Reading Bible principles/Bible Study.

*St. Philip Neri has Bible Studies available to you. It is an excellent opportunity to learn and share with your brother and sister parishioners what the Lord wants to teach you through His Word. Once you start you will find you can't get enough, for He gives you sound instruction and wisdom for living your life. His Word puts you on the path of the ultimate reward, eternal life with Gods chosen family in Heaven.*

Prayer/Talking to God

*There are many types of prewritten prayers available to us. However it may be that one of the most effective for you is to just to talk to God daily, in your own words with reverence, praise, worship, petition, thanksgiving and whatever it is that you have in your heart. Prayer and reading His Word daily will lead your prayer life into a much greater relationship that lines up with His will for your life.*

Questions regarding Catholic Faith/Church teaching

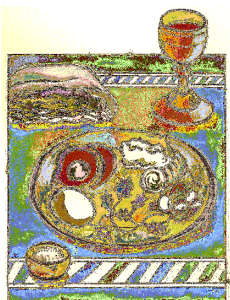
