Reason # 15

### Stronger Marriages

We already mentioned that going to church can help you marriage. Does frequency of attendance matter? Yes, apparently it does. Some studies indicate that the more frequent the church attendance the better the marriage.

According to research by W. Shrum published in the *Review of Religious Research* in 1980, the frequency of church attendance has a significant impact on divorce rates among couples in the United States. The study of 7,029 adults showed that among those who attend church less than once per year thirty-four percent had been divorced or separated. Among those attending church several times per year, twenty-seven percent were divorced – a small improvement. The most significant impact was for those attending monthly or more often, of which only eighteen percent had been divorced or separated. The study controlled for age, education, age at marriage and family income.

## DEACON'S PONDERINGS

I'VE BEEN PONDERING ABORTION. WHAT FOLLOWS IS TAKEN DIRECTLY FROM THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH: HUMAN LIFE MUST BE RESPECTED AND PROTECTED ABSOLUTELY FROM THE MOMENT OF CONCEPTION. FROM THE FIRST MOMENT OF HIS EXISTENCE, A HUMAN BEING MUST BE RECOGNIZED AS HAVING THE RIGHTS OF A PERSON - AMONG WHICH IS THE INVIOLENT RIGHT OF EVERY INNOCENT BEING TO LIFE.

*BEFORE I FORMED YOU IN THE WOMB I KNEW YOU, AND BEFORE YOU WERE BORN I CONSECRATED YOU. MY FRAME WAS NOT HIDDEN FROM YOU, WHEN I WAS BEING MADE IN SECRET, INTRICATELY WROUGHT IN THE DEPTHS OF THE EARTH.*

*SINCE THE FIRST CENTURY THE CHURCH HAS AFFIRMED THE MORAL EVIL OF EVERY PROCURED ABORTION. THIS TEACHING HAS NOT CHANGED AND REMAINS UNCHANGEABLE. DIRECT ABORTION, THAT IS TO SAY, ABORTION WILLED EITHER AS AN END OR A MEANS, IS GRAVELY CONTRARY TO THE MORAL LAW:*

*YOU SHALL NOT KILL THE EMBRYO BY ABORTION AND SHALL NOT CAUSE THE NEWBORN TO PERISH. GOD, THE LORD OF LIFE, HAS ENTRUSTED TO MEN THE NOBLE MISSION OF SAFEGUARDING LIFE, AND MEN MUST CARRY IT OUT IN A MANNER WORTHY OF THEMSELVES. LIFE MUST BE PROTECTED WITH THE UTMOST CARE FROM THE MOMENT OF CONCEPTION: ABORTION AND INFANTICIDE ARE ABOMINABLE CRIMES.*

FORMAL COOPERATION IN AN ABORTION CONSTITUTES A GRAVE OFFENSE. THE CHURCH ATTACHES THE CANONICAL PENALTY OF EXCOMMUNICATION TO THIS CRIME AGAINST HUMAN LIFE. THE CHURCH DOES NOT INTEND TO RESTRICT THE SCOPE OF MERCY. RATHER, SHE MAKES CLEAR THE GRAVITY OF THE CRIME COMMITTED, THE IRREPARABLE HARM DONE TO THE INNOCENT WHO IS PUT TO DEATH, AS WELL AS TO THE PARENTS AND THE WHOLE OF SOCIETY.
