Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

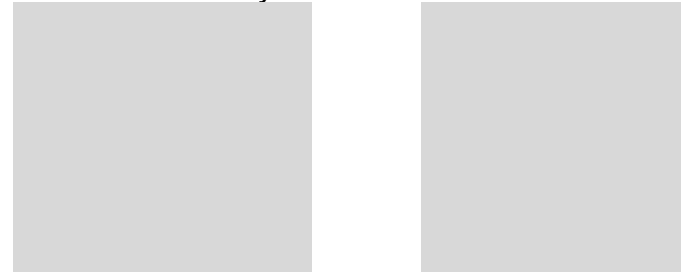

County Executive John R. Leopold announces Anne Arundel County's fourth **Homeless Resource Day to be held on Saturday, March 26 at Glen Burnie High School**. This event is a "one day, one stop" opportunity for individuals and families experiencing homelessness to access benefits, medical care, substance abuse resources, mental health counseling and a variety of other social services. Once again this year because of our economic situation, we are expecting to see more families and individuals seeking help. The Arundel House of Hope is a supporter of this event and is looking to the Winter Relief supporting churches for volunteers to help both on Fri. March 25 and Sat. March 26. Volunteers must be at least 15 years old to help the day before the event and 18 years old to help on the day of the event. **Volunteers are required to attend a 1 ½ hour training which can be attended on any of the following three dates, Tues. March 15th (Annapolis), Thurs March 17th (Millersville), or Saturday March 19th (Ft. Meade).**

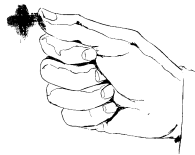

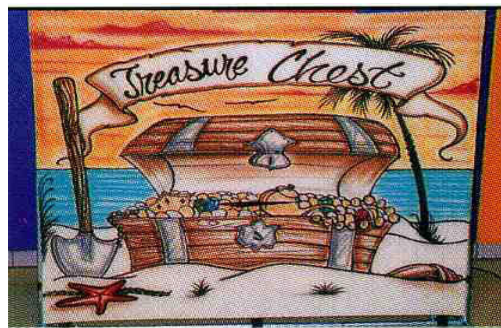
You will not want to miss SPN School's production of the musical
