Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

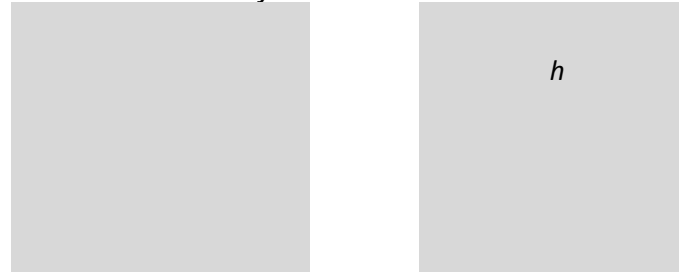

A prayer meeting consists of a time of spontaneous praise and worship, a brief teaching on Christian Values, and a time to share your thoughts with other participants in a small group setting.

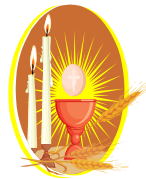
Prayer meeting will begin at 7:00 PM. Personal prayer ministry will be available to anyone upon request.

FISH PRAYER NET

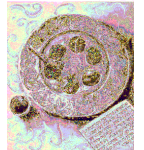
