Greater Resistance to Cancer

Studies indicate that going to church has a positive impact on health. Some researchers have used modern research techniques to attempt to discover how this is so,

A study presented to the American Psychological Association in 1998 showed some interesting relationships between church attendance and immune system functioning. The researchers looked at the religious practices of 112 women with breast cancer. The average age of the women was fifty-three years, and those in the study group had metastatic breast cancer on average for two years. The researchers found that those who were highly religious or attended church often had stronger immune systems, including greater numbers of T-helper cells, lymphocytes and other beneficial disease-fighting cells. They concluded that “spirituality is positively associated with immune status.”
