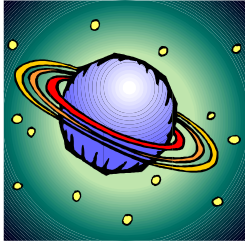

Some of the places we will serve will be at Birthright, the Paschal Senior Center, the Anne Arundel County Food Bank, and with H.O.P.E. Youth will learn new skills as we focus on what it means to put our Catholic faith into action.

When does Summer Madness Happen?

Summer Madness will take place on July 13th, 15th, 20th, 22th, 27th * and 29th, approximately 8:30 a.m.- 5 p.m.

****On Tuesday July 27, 2010 we spend the whole day at Hershey Park (8:30 am -8 pm) as a wrap up to the summer events.***

How does Summer Madness work?

On the mornings of Summer Madness young people will gather by 8:30 am in the Chapel at Holy Trinity Parish Center for warmers, prayer, and announcements before traveling to their service sites. They will work in groups and will serve from approximately 9 am to 12 pm at various sites followed by lunch (not provided), discussing the morning's experiences, and an afternoon fun activity (approximately 1-4 pm). Past fun activities have included bowling, a scavenger hunt, tour of Camden yards, visits to museums, movies, and games.

How much does Summer Madness cost and how do I register?

Cost for the program, including the trip to Hershey Park- **\$140.00** per person.
Service and fun only (no Hershey Park)- **\$85.00** per person.
