Reduced Stress

Going to church could be a factor in reducing your level of stress. Several large studies show that people of religious commitment deal with stress better than those without religious commitment. In fact, the greater the commitment, the better people were able to handle difficult trials and problems.

For example, a study published in *Social Science Medicine* in 1991 suggested that among infrequent church attendees, “new stressful life events and health problems have a negative impact on mental health that is buffered among frequent church attendees”.

Marriage Preparation Program Saint Philip Neri

The community of Saint Philip Neri, in living its Mission Statement, has established a Marriage Preparation policy that went into effect in January, 2008.

This new policy has as its goal the offering of a parish based Pre-Cana experience for all engaged couples. This program through activities, teachings as well as through our hospitality is designed to assist the engaged couple begin their journey as a married couple.

Our program asks all couples contemplating marriage at Saint Philip Neri to complete the following pre-wedding activities:

- ❖ Contact the Marriage Coordinator, Mrs. Margaret Elliott at (410-859-4950) **one year in advance** for the information on this program.
- ❖ **One year prior** to the wedding, place the date of your wedding on the church calendar.
- ❖ As soon as possible, meet with **Father Dale**. This is required whether he or another priest or deacon will perform the ceremony.
- ❖ Attend a Pre Cana experience with a Sponsor Couple from the parish.
- ❖ Attend a weekend, (Friday evening, Saturday) workshop which is offered four times a year entitled, “God’s Plan for a Joy Filled Marriage” presented on DVD by Christopher West.

Meet with the pastor a second time in the process of preparation.

This program has been developed to help the engaged couple to focus on the importance of their marriage as a lifelong commitment not just their wedding day.
