Marriage: Couples who are planning to marry are required to complete the Saint Philip Neri Marriage Program. Please contact the Parish office for information.

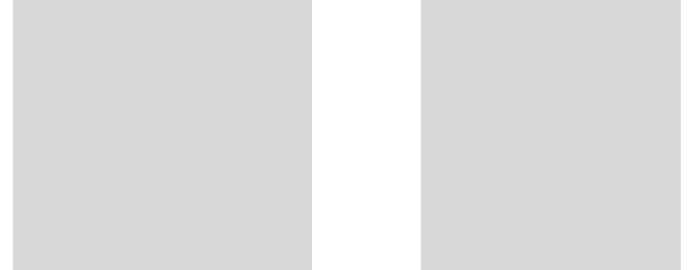

The Annual St. Philip Neri Spring Craft Fair Sponsored by the Home and School Association will be held Saturday, April 9th 9am to 3pm

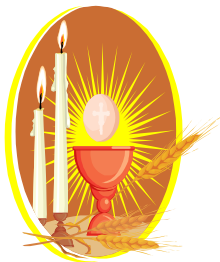

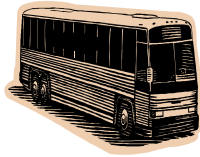

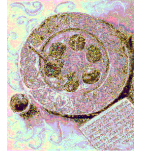
