

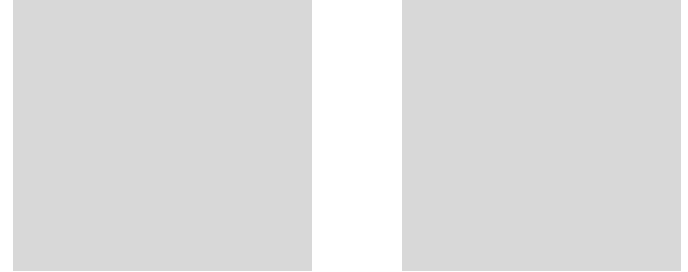

Why Should I get involved?

When Pope Benedict XVI visited the United States in 2008, he said, "**Children deserve to grow up with a healthy understanding of sexuality and its proper place in human relationships.** They should be spared the degrading manifestations and the crude manipulation of sexuality so prevalent today. **They have a right to be educated in authentic moral values** rooted in the dignity of the human person. ... What does it mean to speak of child protection when pornography and violence can be viewed in so many homes through media widely available today?"

"**God created man in his image.**" (Genesis 1:27) Each person has dignity and value because God made us for more than life on earth—He made us for eternity with Him. Each of us has an immortal soul enclosed in a human body. In marriage a man and woman commit themselves, body and soul, to each other. Marital love that is free, total, faithful and fruitful brings happiness and fulfills God's plan. Any action that undermines the unity of body and soul, uses another person as an object, or treats sexuality as simply a physical activity, demeans the dignity of the human person.

Send your Holy Spirit upon us to fill us with Your grace, and keep us pure of heart. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

What you can do to combat pornography during WRAP Week

(This year: Sunday, Oct. 30 through Sunday, Nov. 6, 2011)

AND THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

The **White Ribbon Against Pornography (WRAP) Week** is intended to educate the public about the extent of the pornography problem and what can constitutionally be done about it. Fighting pornography, however, is a year-round challenge. Here are activities an individual or group can do during **WRAP Week** and during the year. - 1. Wear a White Ribbon during this week, people will ask the meaning of the ribbon**
- 2. Make complaints to your U.S. Attorney and State prosecutor about possible violations of federal or state obscenity laws**
- 3. Ask city, county, and state legislators to curb "sexually oriented businesses"**
- 4. Make complaints to businesses that distribute or advertise pornography including those that display sexually offensive magazine covers such as supermarkets and drug stores**
- 5. Write letters to the editor about the pornography problem and its solutions; keep them short**
- 6. Inform your community by distributing literature or having a speaker about the pornography problem and its solutions**
- 7. Educate your community leaders about the harmful effects of pornography**
