“52 GOOD Reasons to Go To Church

Besides the Obvious Ones

Reason # 13

Decreased Juvenile Delinquency

Parents who get their children ready for church each week know that at times it can be a struggle. Studies show the effort may be worth it.

The *Journal of Research in Crime & Delinquency* published a study by R. Stark and D.P.Doyle in 1982. Using a nationwide sample of 1,799 boys below the age of eighteen, they found that the more religious the boys were, the less likely they were to be delinquent. Religious commitment was measured by the boys' own reports of the importance of religions to them and by their frequency of church attendance. The effect was notably stronger in communities where religious commitment was more prevalent, suggesting that where there is a critical mass of church attendance in a community, the likelihood of juvenile delinquency is reduced.

DEACON'S PONDERINGS

I've been pondering the Most Holy Trinity. I have come up with a total blank! The greatest of theologians have never been able to explain the Trinity. So how can we expect a humble deacon to explain the Trinity? Listen to this: God is one! The Father is God; Jesus Christ, His Son, is God; the Most Holy Spirit is God! Yet there is only one God. Yet there are three divine persons! This is our Faith, the very foundation of our Faith. The following is not original. Please don't accuse me of plagiarism. "The most difficult thing about the Trinity Doctrine is that there is no way to adequately explain it. The Trinity is a concept that is impossible for any human being to fully understand, let alone explain. God is infinitely higher than we are, therefore we should not expect to be able to fully understand Him. The Bible teaches that the Father is God (Exodus 3:14), that Jesus is God (John 8:58), and that the Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:3-4). The Bible also teaches that there is only one God (Deuteronomy 6:4; James 2:19). How these two statements of doctrine can both be true is incomprehensible to the human mind. However, this doesn't mean that they're both not true. My Brothers and Sisters, instead of focusing on the Trinity, try to focus on the fact of God's greatness and infinitely higher nature than our own. "Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out! For who has know the mind of the Lord? Or who has become His counselor?" (Romans 11:33-34) Please pray for me. I always pray for you. I love you.
