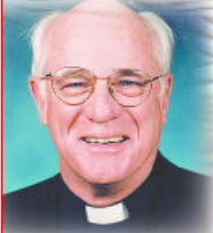

This year's Bid For Hope proceeds will benefit the Arundel House of Hope's new medical clinic. The clinic is the first free-standing (not hospital affiliated)). It provides comprehensive medical services to the county's uninsured through voluntary partnerships with doctors from Baltimore Washington Medical Center and other volunteer physicians' from the community.

2012 will be the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the existence for Arundel House of Hope. A lot has been accomplished in those 20 years. This past year alone they opened the new Patriot House transitional housing program serving Homeless Veterans, two permanent supportive housing programs and the expansion of the new House of Hope Medical Clinic. In 2011 more people were served than ever before including the 45 families through the Homeless Prevention Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP) which ended this year. Over 500 patients visited the New Medical Clinic this past year. Two more permanent supportive housing programs were added, one for men, and the second for women. They built and opened the Patriot House which is the first housing program for Homeless Veterans in Anne Arundel County. The Winter Relief emergency shelter continues to expand with over 65 churches participating this year and serving over 60 homeless men and women each night.

Bid For Hope is the one big fundraiser held each year to cover the cost of the expenses for these programs. All proceeds from the event this year will benefit the new medical clinic. This free clinic helps to benefit all of the uninsured in Anne Arundel County and is not limited to just the homeless.
