Reason # 22

Rising Out of Poverty

Among the most persistent of problems is poverty in the inner cities of America. Consider the data on a problem that politicians, human right activists and social workers have wrestled with for decades.

The National Longitudinal Survey of Youth (NLSY) tracked the development of 12,686 American youths beginning in 1979. Children whose families attended church weekly in both 1979 and 1982 grew up to have an average family income of \$37,000 in 1993. For those whose families never attended church in 1979 or 1982, however, their adult average family income in 1993 was \$24,361 (a difference of \$12,639). The impact of going to church was significant for those who grew up in intact families as well as for those who grew up in broken families.

I THINK THAT THE SEED OF A VOCATION IS PLANTED IN THE HOME, PLANTED AND CULTIVATED ESPECIALLY BY THE PARENTS. LET EACH ONE OF US PRAY FOR VOCATIONS TO THE PRIESTHOOD AND ASK THE GOOD GOD TO HELP OUR YOUNG MEN RESPOND TO THE PROMPTING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. PLEASE PRAY FOR ME. I ALWAYS PRAY FOR YOU. I LOVE YOU.

SOCIAL OUTREACH MINISTRY



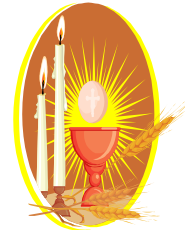
The Social Outreach Ministry is asking for your support to assist us with providing donations of school supplies to children within our surrounding areas who may need assistance for the upcoming school year.
